- This summer's NC Governor's Cup regatta is the 50th to be held since its inauguration in 1957, distinguishing it as one of the oldest, largest, and most venerable in the Southeast. The Regatta includes up to five races over two days. It takes place off Henderson Point on Kerr Lake, known for its expanse of inland water and beautiful tree-lined shores.
- The NC Governor's Cup is more than a Carolina tradition. A number of one-design fleets include the Regatta in their district circuit competitions and SAYRA One Design Championship, attracting some of the best sailors in the country.

DIRECTIONS

Henderson Point State Recreation Area is located on Kerr Lake near the VA-NC border 15 mile north of Henderson NC. From I-85 or US 1 at Henderson, follow NC 39 north. Two miles north of Townsville, turn right onto SR 1356. Then, about three miles further, turn tight on to SR 1359. Follow signs to the Henderson Point State Recreation Area.

JURISDICTION AND RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008*. The Regatta is a *Category A* event. Sailing instructions will be provided at Registration.

CLASS AND COMPETITION

The Sailing Club welcomes one-design centerboard and catamaran classes to compete for the 2007 Governor's Cup. Four boats registered in a given class will guarantee scoring and a trophy for that class. Invited classes include, but are not limited to:

PHRF We will divide these fleets into two courses.

There will be a separate course for: Optimist (Red, White, Blue and Green Fleets).

Fleets of fewer than 4 boats per class will compete under US Sailing Portsmouth or PHRF handicapping rules in: Open Monohull, Open Multi-hull, Open PHRF. Judgments, exceptions, and adjustments to handicaps will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

Fleet trophies will be awarded according to the low-point scoring system of Appendix A4. A boat's series score shall be the total of all her races. This changes RRS A.2 Five races are scheduled; one race shall constitute a regatta

Trophies will be awarded to a class based on the number of boats in a class—

(1-4 boats) 2 trophies, (5-9 boats) 3 trophies, (10-14 boats) 4 trophies., (15 or more boats) 5 trophies

All Optimist Green Fleet sailors will receive Participation Awards.

The NC Governor's Cup is a perpetual trophy engraved with the name of the skipper in his/her class having the best average score based on the NC Governor's Cup high point scoring system. A keep trophy will also be presented.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

Payment by credit card is available with pre-registration until 06/11/07 at www.layline.com under Regatta Registration. Please mail the completed registration or bring it with you.

Discounted fees are offers for prepaid registration postmarked or ordered on the web by 06/11/07, and for US Sailing members.

A \$5 gate fee is collected at the Henderson Point Gate House for those not having an annual pass.

Four boats in a class must be registered by 1030 AM on Saturday to qualify for separate scoring and trophies for that class. Late registrations may be allowed at the scorekeeper's discretion, but late registrants will not affect the number of separate classes scored. **All those pre-registered must go through the registration process at the Regatta.
