## 2019 Piedmont Interclub Challenge – Saturday July 20, 2019



### Notice of Race

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as changed by Appendix D1: Team Racing Rules. See Section 9 for Scoring.

#### 2. Entries

- 2.1. Members of the Carolina Sailing Club or Lake Townsend Yacht Club are eligible to participate in all races.
- 2.2. Competitors may enter by signing in on the registration sheets in the parking lot.
- 2.3. All participants, including crew, must sign the Carolina Sailing Club Release Sheet prior to participation.

#### 3. Fees

- 3.1. There are no fees for this Regatta. NC Parks may charge an entrance fee for Vista Point Recreation Area.

#### 4. Schedule

- 4.1. Registration will take place from 10:00 to 10:45 on Saturday July 20, 2019.
- 4.2. Competitors' meeting will be held at 11:00 in the parking lot at Vista Point.
- 4.3. The Warning Signal for the first Race will be at 12:00 PM. Warning Signals for subsequent races to follow.
- 4.4. Three races are scheduled. A minimum of one race will constitute a regatta.
- 4.5. No races will be started after 4:00 PM.
- 4.6. To alert boats that a race will begin soon, a series of short horn blasts may be made.

#### 5. Venue

- 5.1. The racing area will be located off the launching area at Vista Point at Jordan Lake.

#### 6. Measurements

- 6.1. Yachts must comply with all requirements of their relevant class association.

#### 7. Sailing Instructions

- 7.1. The sailing instructions will be available on the CSC website and a limited number may be available at the competitor's meeting.

#### 8. Courses

- 8.1. Yachts will race around floating marks as described in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 9. Scoring

- 9.1. Scoring will use the rules of RRS Appendix A as changed below. No scores will be excluded.
- 9.2. All boats shall race in a single handicap class.
- 9.3. Handicapping for the races will be in accordance with the Portsmouth Yardstick using the Wind Dependent Handicap Factors. No further modifications will be applied.
- 9.4. The scores from the top five boats from each club will be added together. The club with the lowest score in each race will win that race.
- 9.5. The club which wins most races will win the Piedmont Interclub Challenge. In case of a tie, the results of the final race will determine the winner of the Challenge.

#### 10. Safety

- 10.1. All boats shall comply with all local and state safety regulations, as well as class rules.

#### 11. Clean Regattas

- 11.1. CSC is pleased to support Sailors for the Sea's Clean Regattas program to restore ocean health.
- 11.2. Please recycle and dispose of trash responsibly.
- 11.3. Participants are encouraged to bring reusable water bottles, mugs for coffee, and utensils; avoiding single-use plastics.
- 11.4. On the water trash may be placed aboard official boats.

12.1. Competitors participate in the races at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
