

Carolina Sailing Club 2025 Interclub Challenge

April 13, 2025, at Jordan Lake (Vista Point)

Notice of Race

1. Rules

- 1.1. The Interclub Challenge is a handicapped regatta open to all members of the Carolina Sailing Club, Lake Townsend Yacht Club, or Oak Hollow Sailing Club.
- 1.2. The race will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Sailing Instructions will be provided on the day of the regatta.

2. Pre-Registration

3. Schedule

- 3.1. The event will take place on April 13, 2025
- 3.2. Registration 10:00 – 10:45 am
- 3.3. Competitors Meeting 11:00 am
- 3.4. Warning, Race #1 12:00 pm
- 3.5. Subsequent races to follow

4. Scoring

- 4.1. All boats shall race in a single handicap class.
- 4.2. Handicapping for the races will be in accordance with the Portsmouth Yardstick using the Wind Dependent Handicap Factors.
- 4.3. Each race will be individually scored using low-point scoring. There is no series score.
 - 4.3.1. In case of a tie for a race, the lower score for the first finisher from each club will be used as the tie breaker standard low point scoring determines the winner of that race.
- 4.4. The scores from the top five boats from each club will be added together. The club with the lowest score will be awarded a 1 for that race, the second lowest score will be awarded a 2, and the final club a 3.
- 4.5. The club with the lowest accumulated points from 3 races will win the Interclub Challenge.
 - 4.5.1. In case of a tie overall for the Challenge, the lower score for the first finisher from that club will be used as the tie breaker to determine the overall winner of the Challenge.

5. Disclaimer of Liability

- 5.1. Competitors participate in the races at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
